Random Book-Match Four-Panel Top Four panels are matched with bookmatching pairs on both the inner and outer sides.



Random Match Two-Panel Top Two unique panels are paired using the artisan's sensibilities. Note: Panels are not sourced from the same log.



Book-Match Two-Panel Top Two panels cut from the same log are book-matched and combined



Nakakiori Top A top that combines unique wood grains with the craft of weaving wood in a lattice pattern.



Tabletop (R):

Rounded edges are applied to both ends of the tabletop. This reduces the visual distortion that can make long tabletops appear concave.



Uzukuri Finish:

Enhances the grain of solid wood, giving a bold and dynamic texture using a traditional Japanese technique.



Table with a center grid

It is CondeHouse craftsmanship that realizes this complicated grid consisting of so many wood pieces. The wood grid looks more like woven threads and more beautiful by setting wood pieces with straight grain up. By the combination of many different wood pieces, the top board surface shows various faces according to viewing angles. When light enters, the grid makes beautiful shadows on the floor. A top board and legs are joined by three way miter joints, where craftsmanship is well shown.


Random match

Wood planks or veneer sheets are joined at random, of which expressive surface patterns require craftspeople for high skills and an eye for beauty.

Book match

Two pieces of wood planks or veneer sheets with similar surface patterns are arranged side by side to look like a book opened, which makes surface patterns look more dynamic by grains running symmetrically.
